NMAA Disaster Assistance Checklist for Acequias



1) All Acequias and Parciantes are strongly encouraged to sign up for EWPP

- a) The Emergency Watershed Protection Program, administered by NRCS Natural Resource Conservation Service through a local sponsor, offers assistance to relieve imminent loss of life and damage to property risks: THE COST SHARE REQUIREMENT FOR THIS PROGRAM HAS BEEN WAIVED 100%
- b) Apps for CowCalf/Hermits Peak Fire DUE JULY 1st
- c) See attached app, complete for the acequia, and encourage parciantes to apply individually as well. Once apps are received, NRCS will complete a site visit of the property and determine if it is eligible for mitigation strategies.

2) Each Acequia will designate 1 contact to receive weather and flood alerts

a) Share contacts's name, email and phone number with Chavela Trujillo

3) Legal Assistance Hotline:

- a) Call toll free 888-985-5141
- b) Hotline is staffed Monday-Friday, 9 a.m. 1 p.m. MST. If phone is busy or unanswered, please leave a voicemail and the best way to reach you. They will return your call within 1-2 business days.
- c) Individuals who qualify for assistance will be matched with New Mexico lawyers to provide free, limited legal help. Hotline is primarily for survivors/victims from Colfax, Lincoln, Mora, San Miguel, Valencia counties.
 - i) Assistance with securing FEMA and other benefits available to disaster survivors, including FEMA appeals
 - ii) Assistance with life, medical, and property insurance claims
 - iii) Help with home repair contracts and contractors
 - iv) Replacement of important legal documents destroyed in the disaster
 - v) Assistance with consumer protection matters, remedies, and procedures
 - vi) Counseling on landlord/tenant and mortgage/foreclosure problems

- 6) **Debris Removal:** To enroll in the Full Service Program, submit a Right of Entry Permit to your county government. Permits and submittal instructions are available at: www.nmdhsem.org/2022-wildfires/

- 8) All parciantes engaged in agriculture or with Forested property should **register with the FSA Farm Service Agency** to be eligible for various programs including reseeding, reimbursement for hauling water and the cost of feed, loss of livestock due to the disaster or drought.
